BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 37-2206, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 37-2206. Applications for registration shall be filed with the secretary and SHALL BE accompanied by *** THE FEES HERENAFTER PROVIDED, which shall be applied to defraying the expenses of the board.

SUCH APPLICATIONS SHALL BE ON FORMS PRESCRIBED AND FURNISHED BY THE BOARD, SHALL CONTAIN STATEMENTS MADE UNDER OATH, SHOWING THE APPLICANT'S EDUCATION AND DETAILED SUMMARY OF HIS TECHNICAL WORK, AND SHALL CONTAIN THE NAMES OF

NOT LESS THAN FIVE REFERENCES EXCEPT AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED: FOR ENGINEERING APPLICANTS THREE OR MORE OF THE REFERENCES SHALL BE ENGINEERS HAVING KNOWLEDGE OF APPLICANT'S ENGINEERING EXPERIENCE; FOR LAND SURVEYORS THREE OR MORE OF THE REFERENCES SHALL BE LAND SURVEYORS HAVING KNOWLEDGE OF HIS EXPERIENCE; AND FOR ENGINEERS-IN-TRAINING A SHOWING OF REQUIRED COLLEGE TRAINING SHALL BE SUFFICIENT WITHOUT REFERENCES WHERE SUCH COLLEGE TRAINING IS THE BASIS OF THE APPLICATION, BUT WHERE APPLICATION IS MADE ON THE BASIS OF ENGINEERING EXPERIENCE THERE SHALL BE FIVE REFERENCES, OF WHOM TWO OR MORE SHALL BE ENGINEERS HAVING KNOWLEDGE OF APPLICANT'S ENGINEERING EXPERIENCE.

THE REGISTRATION FEE FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS OR LAND SURVEYORS SHALL BE FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00) WHICH SHALL ACCOMPANY APPLICATION. THE REGISTRATION FEE FOR BOTH PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS SHALL BE TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) WHEN APPLICANT APPLIES FOR BOTH CLASSES OF REGISTRATION AT THE SAME TIME. WHEN A CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION ISSUED BY THE NATIONAL BUREAU OF ENGINEERING REGISTRATION IS ACCEPTED BY THE BOARD AS EVIDENCE OF QUALIFICATION, THE TOTAL FEE FOR REGISTRATION AS PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER SHALL BE FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00).

THE FEE FOR ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING SHALL BE FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) WHICH SHALL ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION AND SHALL INCLUDE THE COST OF EXAMINATION AND ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE. WHEN REGISTRATION AS A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER IS COMPLETED BY AN ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING, AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) SHALL BE PAID BEFORE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE AS A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER.

SHOULD THE BOARD DENY THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION TO ANY APPLICANT THE INITIAL FEE DEPOSITED SHALL BE RETAINED AS AN APPLICATION FEE; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SHOULD THE APPLICANT FAIL TO QUALIFY, * * * SUCH APPLICANT MAY BE RE-EXAMINED WITHIN A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR, WITHOUT THE PAYMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL FEE. AN APPLICANT FOR REGISTRATION SHALL SUBMIT EVIDENCE OF HIS QUALIFICATIONS. BEFORE ISSUING A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION, THE BOARD SHALL SATISFY ITSELF THAT THE APPLICANT IS ENTITLED THERETO. THE BOARD SHALL CONDUCT SUCH EXAMINATION AS IT SHALL DEEM NECESSARY TO DETERMINE THE APPLICANT'S QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION IN THE GRADE OR GRADES FOR WHICH SUCH APPLICATION IS MADE. IT SHALL ALSO INVESTIGATE THE APPLICANT'S MORAL CHARACTER, HABITS, RECORD, TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS ARTICLE CERTAIN TERMS SHALL BE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:

(a) "Land surveying" is surveying having to do with the boundaries or areas of tracts of land for their correct determination and description, and for conveying, when that is involved, or for the establishment or re-establishment of land monuments and boundaries and the platting of lands and subdivisions thereof, and making plats, maps and drawings descriptive of the lands or lines so surveyed, platted or investigated, or for other work involving plane surveying and mapping.

Nothing in this Article shall be construed as authorizing a duly registered professional engineer to make land surveys.

A "land surveyor" is any person who does land surveying.

AN "ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING" IS ANYONE MEETING THE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR SUCH CLASSIFICATION AS HEREINAFTER STATED.

THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS MINIMUM EVIDENCE SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD THAT THE APPLICANT IS QUALIFIED FOR REGISTRATION AS A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER, OR LAND SURVEYOR, OR FOR CERTIFICATION AS AN ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING:

(1) AS A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER: (a) GRADUATION IN AN APPROVED ENGINEERING CURRICULUM OF FOUR YEARS OR MORE FROM A SCHOOL OR COLLEGE APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS OF SATISFACTORY STANDING; AND A SPECIFIC RECORD OF AN ADDITIONAL FOUR YEARS OR MORE OF EXPERIENCE IN ENGINEERING WORK OF A CHARACTER SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD, AND INDICATING THAT THE APPLICANT IS COMPETENT TO PRACTICE ENGINEERING (IN COUNTING YEARS OF EXPERIENCE, THE BOARD AT ITS DISCRETION MAY GIVE CREDIT, NOT IN EXCESS OF ONE YEAR, FOR SATISFACTORY GRADUATE STUDY IN ENGINEERING), PROVIDED THAT IN A CASE WHERE THE EVIDENCE PRESENTED IN THE APPLICATION DOES NOT APPEAR TO THE BOARD CONCLUSIVE NOR WARRANTING THE ISSUING OF A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION, THE APPLICANT MAY BE REQUIRED TO PRESENT FURTHER EVIDENCE FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF THE BOARD, AND MAY ALSO BE REQUIRED TO PASS AN ORAL OR WRITTEN EXAMINATION, OR BOTH, AS THE BOARD MAY DETERMINE; OR (b) A SPECIFIC RECORD OF EIGHT YEARS OR

MORE OF EXPERIENCE IN ENGINEERING WORK OF A CHARACTER SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD AND INDICATING THAT THE APPLICANT IS COMPETENT TO PRACTICE ENGINEERING, AND SUCCESSFULLY PASSING A WRITTEN, OR WRITTEN AND ORAL EXAMINATION DESIGNED TO SHOW KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL APPROXIMATING THAT ATTAINED THROUGH GRADUATION IN AN APPROVED FOUR-YEAR ENGINEERING CURRICULUM.

(2) AS A LAND SURVEYOR: (a) GRADUATION FROM A SCHOOL OR COLLEGE APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS OF SATISFACTORY STANDING, INCLUDING THE COMPLETION OF AN APPROVED COURSE IN SURVEYING; AND AN ADDITIONAL TWO YEARS OR MORE OF EXPERIENCE IN LAND SURVEYING WORK OF A CHARACTER SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD AND INDICATING THAT THE APPLICANT IS COMPETENT TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING AND MAY ALSO BE REQUIRED TO PASS AN ORAL OR WRITTEN EXAMINATION; OR (b) A SPECIFIC RECORD OF SIX YEARS OR MORE OF EXPERIENCE IN LAND SURVEYING WORK OF A CHARACTER SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD AND INDICATING THAT THE APPLICANT IS COMPETENT TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING; APPLICANT MAY ALSO BE REQUIRED TO PASS AN ORAL OR WRITTEN EXAMINATION.

(3) AS AN ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING: (a) GRADUATION IN AN ACCREDITED ENGINEERING CURRICULUM OF FOUR SCHOLASTIC YEARS OR MORE FROM A SCHOOL OR COLLEGE APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS OF SATISFACTORY STANDING, AND SUCCESSFULLY PASSING A WRITTEN EXAMINATION IN THE BASIC ENGINEERING SUBJECTS; OR (b) A SPECIFIC RECORD OF FOUR YEARS OR MORE OF EXPERIENCE IN ENGINEERING WORK OF A CHARACTER SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD, AND SUCCESSFULLY PASSING A WRITTEN EXAMINATION IN THE BASIC ENGINEERING SUBJECTS.

No person shall be eligible for registration as a PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER OR LAND SURVEYOR OR CERTIFICATION AS AN ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING *** WHO IS NOT OF GOOD CHARACTER AND REPUTATION AND A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES.

IN CONSIDERING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS, ENGINEERING TEACHING MAY BE CONSTRUED AS ENGINEERING EXPERIENCE.

THE SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF EACH YEAR OF AN APPROVED CURRICULUM IN ENGINEERING IN A SCHOOL OR COLLEGE APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS OF SATISFACTORY STANDING, WITHOUT GRADUATION, SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS EQUIVALENT TO A YEAR OF

EXPERIENCE. GRADUATION IN A CURRICULUM OTHER THAN ENGINEERING FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OF RECOGNIZED STANDING MAY BE CONSIDERED AS EQUIVALENT TO TWO YEARS OF EXPERIENCE; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT NO APPLICANT SHALL RECEIVE CREDIT FOR MORE THAN FOUR YEARS OF EXPERIENCE BECAUSE OF UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS.

ANY PERSON HAVING THE NECESSARY QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED IN THIS ACT TO ENTITLE HIM TO REGISTRATION SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR SUCH REGISTRATION ALTHOUGH HE MAY NOT BE PRACTICING HIS PROFESSION AT THE TIME OF MAKING HIS APPLICATION.

(b) "Professional Engineering" means the practice of any branch of the profession of engineering, other than military engineering. * * *

THE MERE EXECUTION, AS A CONTRACTOR, OF WORK DESIGNED BY A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER, OR THE SUPERVISION OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF SUCH WORK AS A FOREMAN OR SUPERINTENDENT SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO BE THE PRACTICE OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING.

A "Professional Engineer" is anyone who practices professional engineering.

(c) ANY surveying and/OR engineering work done by or under the authority of any village, town, city, county or other political subdivision, or the State of Wyoming, shall be performed by or under the direction of a duly registered professional engineer or land surveyor, as provided by this Article, and no town, city or county surveyor or engineer, or surveyor or engineer employed by the State of Wyoming, shall be eligible FOR EMPLOYMENT IN SUCH POSITION OR as a candidate for appointment, re-appointment, election or re-election TO SUCH POSITION, until he has OBTAINED a certificate of registration, authorizing him to do the class of work for which he is employed.

(d) Upon the payment of a fee of FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00) the board may issue a certificate of registration to any person who holds a like unexpired certificate issued to him by proper authority in any state or territory of the United States or the District of Columbia, provided the requirements by law for registration of professional engineers and land surveyors are of equal standard and satisfactory to the board.

* * *

Section 2. That Section 37-2212, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 37-2212. A CERTIFICATE of registration shall expire on the 31st day of December of the year following the year of issuance thereof, and shall become invalid upon that date unless renewed. A renewal certificate shall be issued by the board upon application therefor and the payment of a fee of SIX (\$6.00) dollars by the applicant. Renewal certificates shall run for a period of two years from the 31st day of December in each instance and shall then expire. Additional renewals may be obtained at the end of each two-year period in the same manner as provided for the first renewal. * * * THE FAILURE ON THE PART OF ANY REGISTRANT TO RENEW HIS CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED ABOVE SHALL NOT DEPRIVE SUCH PERSON OF THE RIGHT OF RENEWALS, BUT THE FEE TO BE PAID FOR THE RENEWAL OF A CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED ABOVE SHALL BE INCREASED TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) FOR EACH MONTH OR A FRACTION OF A MONTH THAT PAYMENT OF A RENEWAL IS DELAYED; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE RENEWAL FEE SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF THE REGISTRATION FEE; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD SHALL BY REGISTERED MAIL, AT LEAST THREE MONTHS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF HIS CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OR RENEWAL, NOTIFY THE REGISTRANT, AT THE LAST POST OFFICE ADDRESS GIVEN BY HIM, OF THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF HIS CERTIFICATE.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 1954.

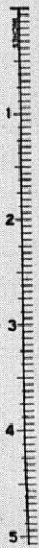

(c) ANY surveying and/OR engineering work done by or under the authority of any village, town, city, county or other political subdivision, or the State of Wyoming, shall be performed by or under the direction of a duly registered professional engineer or land surveyor, as provided by this Article, and no town, city or county surveyor or engineer, or surveyor or engineer employed by the State of Wyoming, shall be eligible FOR EMPLOYMENT IN SUCH POSITION OR as a candidate for appointment, re-appointment, election or re-election TO SUCH POSITION, until he has OBTAINED a certificate of registration, authorizing him to do the class of work for which he is employed.

(d) Upon the payment of a fee of ^{FIFTY} TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00) the board may issue a certificate of registration to any person who holds a like unexpired certificate issued to him by proper authority in any state or territory of the United States or the District of Columbia, provided the requirements by law for registration of professional engineers and land surveyors are of equal standard and satisfactory to the board.

Section 2. That Section 37-2212, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 37-2212. A CERTIFICATE of registration shall expire on the 31st day of December of the year following the year of issuance thereof, and shall become invalid upon that date unless renewed. A renewal certificate shall be issued by the board upon application therefor and the payment of a fee of SIX (\$6.00) dollars by the applicant. Renewal certificates shall run for a period of two years from the 31st day of December in each instance and shall then expire. Additional renewals may be obtained at the end of each two-year period in the same manner as provided for the first renewal. *** THE FAILURE ON THE PART OF ANY REGISTRANT TO RENEW HIS CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED ABOVE SHALL NOT DEPRIVE SUCH PERSON OF THE RIGHT OF RENEWALS, BUT THE FEE TO BE PAID FOR THE RENEWAL OF A CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED ABOVE SHALL BE INCREASED TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) FOR EACH MONTH OR A FRACTION OF A MONTH THAT PAYMENT OF A RENEWAL IS DELAYED; ^{omit} PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE MAXIMUM TIME LIMIT FOR RENEWAL SHALL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE RENEWAL FEE SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF THE REGISTRATION FEE; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD SHALL BY REGISTERED MAIL, AT LEAST THREE MONTHS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF HIS CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OR RENEWAL, NOTIFY THE REGISTRANT, AT THE LAST POST OFFICE ADDRESS GIVEN BY HIM, OF THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF HIS CERTIFICATE.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 1954.
