2 requiring occupied cabooses as specified; and providing

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

5 Section 1. W.S. 37-9-803 is created to read:

7 (a) Any train running through or within the bound-
8 aries of the state of Wyoming which is over one thousand
9 five hundred (1,500) feet in length or which carries a
