

8 Section 1. W.S. 23.1-33 by creating a new subsection  
9 (f) is amended to read:

10 23.1-33. Fees; restrictions.

11 (f) AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FEE OF TWENTY PERCENT  
12 (20%) OF THE FEE FOR EACH LICENSE UNDER SUBSECTION (b) OF  
13 THIS SECTION SHALL BE COLLECTED PRIOR TO ISSUING THE LI-  
14 CENSE. PROCEEDS OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE SHALL BE CREDITED  
15 TO AN ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GAME AND FISH FUND. ANNUALLY, AN  
16 EQUIVALENT AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT COLLECTED UNDER THIS
