

Enrolled Act, No. 11, House of Representatives,
STATE OF WYOMING

AN ACT providing for payment of accounts already incurred, and providing
an appropriation for the necessary contingent expenses of the
Judge of the First Judicial District of the State of Wyoming, previous
to April 1, 1915.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the
State Treasury of the State of Wyoming not otherwise appropriated, the
sum of Two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), or so much thereof as may be
necessary, to pay bills now due and to pay necessary contingent expenses
of the Judge of the First Judicial District, incurred previous to
April 1, 1915.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and
after the date of its passage.
