AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RELIEF OF FRED PATEE IN ALLOWING INTEREST ON RENT WRONGFULLY PAID TO, AND RECEIVED BY, THE STATE OF WYOMING, IN THE SUM OF NINE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE (\$999.00) DOLLARS, AND INTEREST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That the sum of Nine Hundred Ninety-nine (\$999.00) Dollars, together with 6% interest thereon from March 5, 1927, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be appropriated out of the funds into which same were originally taken into account, for the relief of Fred Patee in allowing interest on rent paid to, and received by the State of Wyoming, from said Fred Patee, on lease on Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirty-two (32) North, Range Seventy-nine (79) West of the 6th P.M., said interest amounting to Nine Hundred Ninety-nine (\$999.00) Dollars on March 5th, 1927, which said land did not belong to the State of Wyoming when said lease was executed and said rentals were paid, and does not now and never has belonged to the State of Wyoming.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
