

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 35-7-366(a) and (b) is amended to
 7 read:

8 35-7-366. Penalties.

9 (a) Any person violating any provision of ~~this--act~~

1 W.S. 35-7-350 THROUGH 35-7-374 or regulation thereunder
2 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be
3 fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or
4 imprisoned in the county jail for not more than one (1)
5 year, or both, for the first offense, and upon conviction
6 for a subsequent offense shall be fined not more than one
7 thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned in the county
8 jail for not more than a ONE (1) year, or both. Any
9 offense committed more than three (3) years after a pre-
10 vious conviction shall be considered a first offense.

11 (b) The commissioner may bring an action to enjoin
12 the violation or threatened violation of any provision of
13 ~~this-act~~ or any regulation made pursuant to ~~this-act~~ W.S.
14 35-7-350 THROUGH 35-7-374 in a court of competent juris-
15 diction of the county in which the violation occurs or is
16 about to occur. The action may be initiated by the attor-
17 ney general or the district attorney for the county in
18 which the violation has or is about to occur.
