- (a) UPON PAYMENT TO THE WYOMING LIVESTOCK BOARD AN ANNUAL FEE BASED ON THE NUMBER OF LIVESTOCK TO BE MOVED ON THE SPECIAL PERMIT INSPECTION AS SPECIFIED IN THE GRAD-UATED SCALE SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION, an inspector may issue permits for the movement of horses, mules or cattle from an accustomed range or ranch in the county to another accustomed range or ranch, not contiguous, in another county or counties, without WITH inspection for brands and ownership, provided such THE movement is for the purpose of pasturing, ranging or feeding the livestock and there is no change of ownership. An accustomed range or ranch shall be deemed to mean a range or ranch which is used for two or more consecutive years for such THESE purposes. REGULAR INSPECTION PROCEDURES SHALL BE FOLLOWED ON EACH AND EVERY MOVEMENT OF LIVESTOCK UNDER THIS PERMIT WITHOUT CHARGE AT TIME OF INSPECTION. THE SCALE FOR DETERMINING THE COST OF THE ANNUAL FEE IS:
- 23 (i) 0-50 HEAD, NOT TO EXCEED \$5;
- 24 (ii) 51-250 HEAD, NOT TO EXCEED \$20;
- 25 (iii) 251-750 HEAD, NOT TO EXCEED \$60;

3	(b) Such THE permits shall be issued only to bona
4	fide owners of ranch lands within the county or to legal
5	residents of the state, or to the authorized agents of
6	such owners or legal residents. Each permit shall be good
7	for one year from date of issuance unless sooner revoked,
8	for cause, by the agency. Such THE permits shall be non-
9	transferable. Each permit shall be made in triplicate;
10	the original shall be given to the permittee, one copy
