

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that George G. Ross, deceased, late a citizen of the United States, residing at Riverton, in the county of Fremont and State of Wyoming, did invent a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fish Lure or Similar Article, and I, Clara M. Nelson, of Riverton, in the county of Fremont and State of Wyoming, administratrix of the estate of the said George G. Ross, deceased, do hereby declare the following is a specification of the invention, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of a fish lure or similar article showing the new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

Figure 3 is an end elevational view.

Figure 4 is a sectional view taken substantially on the line 4—4 of Figure 1.

Figure 5 is a sectional view taken substantially on the line 5-5 of Figure 2.

Figure 6 is a perspective view thereof.
