

3 will purchase a number of tickets on any air carrier which
4 will provide an adequate level of service to Wyoming
5 communities; providing for use of the tickets; providing
6 for an appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 10-3-202 is amended to read:

9 10-3-202. Authority to provide air transportation to
10 departments and agencies of state.

1 (a) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED BY SUBSECTION (b) OF THIS
2 SECTION, the commission may provide air transportation to
3 departments and agencies of state government under condi-
4 tions which are considered by the department or agency
5 head to be urgent and to justify ~~such~~ air transportation
6 and when justified within the limits of W.S. 9-7-504
7 9-4-204(p) and 9-7-505 9-4-205(e).

8 (b) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A COMMITTEE TO BE
9 COMPOSED OF ONE (1) REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 ADMINISTRATION AND FISCAL CONTROL, ONE (1) LEGISLATOR, ONE
11 (1) REPRESENTATIVE OF THE WYOMING AIRPORT OPERATORS ASSO-
12 CIATION, ONE (1) REPRESENTATIVE OF THE AERONAUTICS COMMIS-
13 SION AND ONE (1) MEMBER AT LARGE. COMMITTEE MEMBERS SHALL
14 BE REIMBURSED FOR TRAVEL AND RECEIVE PER DIEM IN THE SAME
15 AMOUNT AND MANNER AS STATE EMPLOYEES. THE COMMITTEE SHALL
16 SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1,
17 1983, AND RECOMMEND (1) WHAT ROUTES WOULD BE ECONOMICALLY
18 ATTRACTIVE TO COMMUTER AIRLINES CONSIDERING BOTH STATE
19 EMPLOYEE USE AND USE BY THE PUBLIC, (2) THE NUMBER OF
20 TICKETS ON THE ROUTES WHICH THE STATE WOULD USE AND (3)
21 THE TERMS AND DURATION OF CONTRACT FOR SERVICE WHICH THE
22 STATE SHOULD ENTER INTO, AFTER COMPETITIVE BID, WITH AN
23 ACCEPTABLE AIR CARRIER. UPON APPROVAL BY THE GOVERNOR,

1 THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION AND FISCAL CONTROL SHALL
2 PREPARE AND SUBMIT SUITABLE CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE STATE
3 AND ONE (1) OR MORE COMMUTER AIRLINES WHEREBY THE STATE
4 AGREES TO PURCHASE A LIMITED NUMBER OF TICKETS AND THE
5 COMMUTER AIRLINE AGREES TO MAINTAIN A SPECIFIED ROUTE OR
6 ROUTES WITHIN WYOMING.

7 (c) UPON RECEIPT OF CONTRACTS FOR BID FROM THE
8 DEPARTMENT, THE COMMISSION, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
9 GOVERNOR, SHALL LET THE CONTRACTS FOR BID WITH AIR CAR-
10 RRIERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING COMMUTER AIRLINE
11 SERVICE FOR RECOMMENDED WYOMING COMMUNITIES. THE GOVERNOR
12 MAY BY CONTRACT OBLIGATE THE STATE OF WYOMING TO PURCHASE
13 A NEGOTIATED NUMBER OF TICKETS FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED
14 TWO (2) YEARS FROM ANY COMMUTER AIRLINE WHICH WILL PROVIDE
15 AN APPROVED LEVEL OF SERVICE TO WYOMING COMMUNITIES. THE
16 AIRLINE TICKETS MAY BE USED BY ANY STATE EMPLOYEE IF
17 AIRLINE TRANSPORTATION IS APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE
18 STATE AGENCY UNDER THE CONDITIONS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSEC-
19 TION (a) OF THIS SECTION.

20 Section 2. Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) is
21 appropriated from the general fund to the governor for the
