A BILL

For

An ACT providing to create a STATE FLAG for the STATE of WYOMING.

- Section 1 Be it enacted by the LEGISLATURE of the STATE of WYOMING; That a STATE FLAG be and the same is hereby adopted, to be used on all occasions when the STATE is officially and publicly represented, with the privilege of use by all Citizens upon all such occasions as they may deem fitting and appropriate. Said FLAG shall consist of three alternate stripes of pale blue and white bunting, silk, or other appropriate material; said stripes to be of equal width and parallel with the staff, the white stripe being the middle one and to have in its longitudinal center a correct outline or color reproduction of the STATE SEAL whose diameter shall be Five sixths ($5/6$) of the width of the white stripe; the proportion of the flag being a width of two-thirds ($2/3$) its length. All penalties provided by the laws of this STATE for misuse of the national FLAG shall ~~shall~~ be applicable to the said STATE FLAG.

- Section 3 This ^{act} shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
