A BILL

For An ACT providing to create a STATE FLAG for the STATE of WYOMING.

Section I

Be it enacted by the LEGISLATURE of the STATE of WYOMING; That a STATE FLAG be and the same is hereby adopted to be used on all occasions when the STATE is officially and publicly represented, with the privilige of use by all Citizens upon all such occasions as they may deem fitting and appropiate. Said FLAG shall consist of three alternate stripes of pale blue and white bunting, silk, or other appropriate material; said stripes to be of equal width and paralell with the staff, the white stripe being the middle one and to have in its longitudinal center a correct outline or color reproduction of the STATE SEAL whose diameter shall be Five sixth's (5/6) of the width of the white stripe; the ; proportion of the flag being a width of two-thirds(2/3)its length, All penalties provided by the laws of this STATE for misuse of the national FLAG shall shell be applicable to the said STATE FLAG.
