## **CHAPTER 94**

Original House Bill No. 233

## VETERANS EXEMPTION CONTINGENT—APPROPRIATION

AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Treasurer as a Veterans Exemption Contingent to be paid to the counties of Wyoming, for the loss of revenue by municipalities, counties and school districts, and for no other purpose, and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

## Reimbursement To Counties For Loss of Revenue

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Treasurer out of any funds in the State Treasury of the State of Wyoming, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Two Million Five Hundred

Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, as a Veterans Exemption Contingent, to be paid to the counties of Wyoming, in the two years ending June 30, 1959, for loss of revenue by municipalities, counties and school districts, as provided by law, and for no other purpose.

Section 2. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
