1 AN ACT to amend section 20-3 of the statutes relating to
2 parental consent to marry; and providing that consent is
3 required for persons under 18 years of age.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

5 Section 1. Section 20-3 of the statutes is amended
6 to read:

7 20-3. Parent's, etc., consent to marriage; when
8 required. When either party is ~~a-minor~~ UNDER 18 YEARS OF
9 AGE, no license shall be granted without the verbal con-
10 sent, if present, and written consent, if absent, of the
11 father, if living, if not, then of the mother of such
12 ~~minor~~ PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE, or of the guardian or
13 person under whose care and government such ~~minor~~ PERSON
14 UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE may be, which written consent shall
15 be proved by the testimony of at least one competent
16 witness.
