

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to reauthorize the  
2 Federal-Aid Highway Program.

3 WHEREAS, the 99th Congress adjourned without  
4 reauthorizing the Federal-Aid Highway Program with the  
5 result that the program ran out of new money on September  
6 30, 1986; and

7 WHEREAS, the state of Wyoming exhausted its federal-  
8 aid highway funds to all intents and purposes on December  
9 31, 1986, and cannot undertake essential new federally  
10 assisted contracts without assurance that the 100th Con-  
11 gress will enact reauthorization legislation; and

12 WHEREAS, an extended delay in reauthorization could

1 result in the loss of a significant part, if not all, of  
2 the 1987 construction season in Wyoming.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE LEG-  
4 ISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

5 Section 1. That the incoming 100th Congress is urged  
6 to reauthorize the Federal-Aid Highway Act at the earliest  
7 possible time by reaffirming areas of agreement between  
8 House and Senate conferees, which were reached in the  
9 closing hours of the 99th Congress, as a starting point,  
10 and by setting aside for separate consideration those  
11 issues in contention that prevented passage of this  
12 vitally important legislation in 1986.

13 Section 2. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming  
14 transmit copies of this Resolution to the President of the  
15 United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Repre-  
16 sentatives of the United States and to each member of the  
17 Wyoming Congressional Delegation.



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
