An act to repeal section 3815 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, relating to the payment of taxes in county orders or warrants, and so much of section 1827 of said Revised Statutes as relates to the same subject, and also an act entitled "An Act amending and re-enacting section thirty eight hundred and fifteen of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming concerning the manner of payment of taxes," approved December 24, 1890, relating to the same subject, and all acts and parts of acts relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. That section thirty-eight hundred and fifteen(3815) of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, and so much of section eighteen hundred and twenty-seven(1827) as relates to or provides for the receipt or payment of county orders or warrants in payment of taxes, and also an act entitled "An Act amending and re-enacting section thirty-eight hundred and fifteen of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, concerning the manner of payment of taxes," approved December 24, 1890, the said act being chapter ~~xi~~ sixteen(16) of the Session Laws of 1890-1, and all acts and parts of acts relating to or providing for the payment of any taxes in whole or in part in county orders or warrants, be and the same are, all and singular, hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

SECTION 1. That hereafter all taxes due from any person, association or corporation to the State of Wyoming, or any County thereof, shall be paid in money only.

SEC. 2. That Section 3815, of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, and Chapter 16, of the Session Laws of the State of Wyoming, enacted by the First State Legislature and approved December 24, 1890, and all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. That Section 1827, of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, be, and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

SEC. 1827. County orders or warrants properly attested shall be entitled to a preference as to payment according to date of presentation and acceptance at the Treasurer's office; the oldest date to have the preference.
