1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 15-5-302(d) and 15-5-309 by creating  
 2 a new subsection (d) relating to policemen survivor bene-  
 3 fits; authorizing a benefit increase for survivors who  
 4 were not covered under a general benefit increase in 1979;  
 5 providing for the cost of the benefit to be amortized with  
 6 other state payments to policemen pension funds; and pro-  
 7 viding for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1. W.S. 15-5-302(d) and 15-5-309 by creating  
 10 a new subsection (d) are amended to read:

1        15-5-302. Pension fund; contributions; salary deduc-  
2        tions; unfunded liability; city or town and state respon-  
3        sibilities.

4        (d) To assist the cities and towns in the payment of  
5        the unfunded accrued liability of the existing account and  
6        to assist in providing a benefit adjustment as specified  
7        in W.S. 15-5-307(c) and 15-5-309(c) AND (d), in addition  
8        to the city or town contributions specified in subsection  
9        (c) of this section the state treasurer, after approval by  
10       the legislature, shall pay from the state general fund in  
11       equal annual installments seven hundred ~~thirty-three~~  
12       FORTY-TWO thousand dollars ~~(\$733,000.00)~~ (\$742,000.00)  
13       until the total unfunded accrued liability including the  
14       amount resulting from the benefit adjustment is paid, but  
15       not to exceed twenty (20) years commencing July 1, 1985.  
16       The state treasurer shall pay to each city or town fund  
17       from each annual installment the following amount:

4        15-5-309. Death benefits; surviving spouse and chil-  
5        dren; amounts; length of payments; benefit adjustment.

6            (d)    EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1987, ANY SURVIVING SPOUSE AND  
7    ANY SURVIVING CHILD OF ANY OFFICER WHO DIED PRIOR TO JULY  
8    1, 1979 WHILE A SWORN MEMBER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF  
9    ANY CITY OR TOWN SUBJECT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL RECEIVE A  
10   BENEFIT IN AN AMOUNT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (a) OF THIS  
11   SECTION.

12           Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1987.


