1. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-3-106, the proposed filing be, and it hereby is suspended for investigation and the Commission's final order, for the final three (3) month term prescribed by subsection (c) commencing after the 30 days' notice term provided for in subsection (b).
2. Nothing herein shall prevent the Commission from holding public hearings and taking final action in this case at any time during the suspension period if so ordered by the Commission.
3. This *Order* is effective immediately.
