- 3 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
- 4 Section 1. W.S. 9-7-221 is created to read:
- 5 9-7-221. Industrial enhancement program account.
- 6 There is created an industrial enhancement pro-7 gram account within the earmarked revenue fund which shall 8 be administered by the Wyoming science, technology and 9 energy authority as specified in this section. Interest 10 earned on fures in the account shall accrue to the 11 To the extent that the legislature appropriates account. 12 funds to the account, plus interest earned and of revenues 13 from any other source, the authority may enter into agree-14 ments for applied research and product development for any 15 product or process the success of which would contribute 16 to diversification of the state's economy, increase value added and to the state's raw materials as determined by 17 18 the authority.
- 19 (b) W.S. 9-7-204, 9-7-205, 9-7-211 and 9-7-215
 20 through 9-7-217 apply to transactions of the authority
 21 involving the industrial diversification program account.

- 1 (c) In addition, the authority:
- 2 (i) Shall contribute no more than fifty percent
- 3 (50%) of funding to any applied research project supported
- 4 under this section. Remaining matching funds shall be
- 5 obtained from nonstate sources;
- 6 (ii) Shall prepare written requests for propos-
- 7 als explaining application guidelines for wide distribu-
- 8 tion across Wyoming;
- 9 (iii) Shall provide for review and evaluation of
- 10 each application using outside experts, as appropriate;
- 11 (iv) Shall give priority for funding to projects
- with greatest cemonstrated potential to expand production,
- value added, and tax base of Wyoming;
- 14 (v) May enter into any form of agreement to
- 15 receive royalties or other revenue or interests for pro-
- viding financial assistance in the development of a proj-
- 17 ect or process consistent with the limitations of the
- 18 Wyoming constitution.
- Section 2. W.S. 9-7-202(a) (vii) is amended to read:
- 9-7-202. Definitions.

- 1 (a) As used in this act:
- 2 (vii) "This act" means W.S. 9-7-201 through
- 9-7-2209-7-221.
- 4 Section 3.
- 5 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund
- 6 including revenues which are available to the general fund
- 7 due to accelerated distributions or early recognition of
- 8 revenues resulting from compliance with generally accepted
- 9 accounting principles, the following specified amounts for
- 10 the following specified purposes:
- 11 (i) live hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00)
- 12 to the industrial diversification program account created
- under section 1 of this act;
- 14 (ii) Four hundred eight thousand dollars
- 15 (\$408,000.00) to the department of commerce to fund mar-
- 16 keting and international trade efforts. Two (2) additional
- 17 full-time positions are authorized the department of com-
- 18 merce for international trade program activities.
- 19 Section 4.
- 20 (a) The department of commerce, in consultation with

- 1 the economic development and stabilization board, small
- 2 business development center personnel, the science, tech-
- 3 nology and energy authority board, local economic develop-
- 4 ment organization and private industry groups, shall,
- 5 through or by contract with consultants as appointed, sub-
- 6 mit a comprehensive plan for economic development contain-
- 7 ing, at a minimum:
- 8 (i) Wyoming's competitive advantages, including
- 9 a survey of infrastructural and economic development
- 10 assets at all governmental, private, and educational lev-
- 11 els;
- 12 (ii) An analysis of successful economic develop-
- 13 ment programs in other states that may be successful if
- 14 implemented in Wyoming;
- 15 (iii) Suggestions for alternative structures of
- organizations to facilitate delivery of economic develop-
- 17 ment services and programs;
- 18 (iv) Recommendations for modifications to exist-
- 19 ing economic development programs and organizational
- 20 structures consistent with the vision for economic devel-
- 21 opment enunciated in the plans.

- 1 (b) The plan shall be submitted to the legislature
- 2 not later than December 1, 1993.
- 3 The governor shall select a consultant review 4 committee of such size as he determines from the entities listed in subsection (a) of this section to assist the 5 6 department of commerce in selecting appropriate consul-7 tants and other persons with necessary technical expertise 8 to develop the plan. The department shall not enter into 9 any contract under this section without the approval of a 10 majority of the members appointed to the committee by the 11 governor.
- 12 (d) There is appropriated from the general fund to
 13 the department: of commerce fifty thousand dollars
 14 (\$50,000.00) to be expended to develop and submit the plan
 15 required under this section. This appropriation shall be
 16 expended:
- (i) To the extent necessary to match a grant from the federal economic development administration if the state is awarded such a grant; or
- 20 (ii) If a grant is not awarded, in its entirety
 21 as necessary to develop and submit the plan required under
 22 this section.

- 1 Section 5. This act is effective July 1, 1993, except
- that section 4 is effective immediately upon completion of
- all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by
- 4 Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
