1 AN ACT to create sections 31-276.15 through 31-276.19 of
2 the statutes relating to identification cards; providing
3 Wyoming residents who do not possess Wyoming driver's
4 licenses may purchase a Wyoming identification card from
5 the department of revenue; and providing penalties.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

7 Section 1. Sections 31-276.15 through 31-276.19 of
8 the statutes are created to read:

9 31-276.15. Identification cards for residents.

10 (a) Any Wyoming resident 16 years of age or older
11 who does not have a valid Wyoming driver's license may be
12 issued an identification card by the department of
13 revenue, state tax commission, hereafter called the
14 department, certified by the applicant and attested by the
15 department as to the true name, correct age, and any other
16 identifying data as the department may require. Every
17 application for an identification card shall be signed and

1 verified by the applicant.

2 (b) The department shall issue an identification
3 card only to a Wyoming resident who does not have a valid
4 Wyoming driver's license, and only upon receipt of such
5 documentary evidence of the age and identity of the appli-
6 cant as the department requires.

7 31-276.16. Contents of card. The identification
8 card shall resemble in appearance, so far as is practi-
9 cable, a Wyoming driver's license. It shall adequately
10 describe the registrant, bear the registrant's picture,
11 and bear the following: "State of Wyoming" -- "Identifi-
12 cation Card No. ___" -- "This card is provided solely for
13 the purpose of identification of the person described on
14 the card who was not the holder of a Wyoming driver's li-
15 cense as of the date of issuance of the card."

16 31-276.17. Expiration; renewal; records; duplicate
17 cards; corrected cards.

18 (a) Identification cards shall expire or may be
19 renewed within the same time periods for expiration or
20 renewal of Wyoming driver's licenses as provided in
21 section 31-268(a) of the statutes. The department shall
22 keep records of all pertinent data contained in identifi-
23 cation cards. At the end of one year after an identifi-
24 cation card has expired and not been renewed, the depart-
25 ment shall destroy any record of the card.

1 (b) In the event an identification card is lost,
2 destroyed, or mutilated, the person to whom it was issued
3 may obtain a duplicate upon furnishing satisfactory proof
4 of that fact to the department and furnishing the same
5 documentary evidence as for an original identification
6 card.

7 (c) In the event any information contained in the
8 identification card becomes inaccurate, the person to whom
9 it was issued may obtain a corrected card upon furnishing
10 satisfactory proof of that fact to the department, fur-
11 nishing the same documentary evidence as for an original
12 identification card, and surrendering the original iden-
13 tification card.

14 31-276.18. Fees. Every applicant for an original,
15 renewal, duplicate, or corrected identification card shall
16 pay \$1 to the department. The state treasurer shall
17 credit identification card fees to the general fund.

18 31-276.19. Prohibited acts.

19 (a) No person shall:

- 20 (i) Possess any cancelled, fictitious,
21 fraudulently altered, or fraudulently
22 obtained identification card;
23 (ii) Lend his identification card to any
24 other person or knowingly permit its use
25 by another;

1 (iii) Display or represent any identification
2 card not issued to him as being his
3 card;

4 (iv) Photograph, photostat, duplicate, or in
5 any way reproduce any identification
6 card or facsimile thereof in such a man-
7 ner that it could be mistaken for a
8 valid identification card nor possess
9 such a reproduction;

10 (v) Procure an identification card by false
11 swearing, fraud, or false statement of
12 any kind or in any form.

13 (b) Any person who is convicted of or pleads guilty
14 to any violation of this section may be fined up to \$100
15 to which may be added imprisonment in the county jail for
16 a period not to exceed six months.
