7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 30-3-312 is created to read:

9 30-3-312. Certification of surface mine foremen and

1 mine examiners; optional, qualifications.

2 (a) The examining board may issue:

3 (i) Mine foreman certificates to qualified
4 applicants desiring to work as a mine foreman, assistant
5 mine foreman or safety engineer in a surface mine;

6 (ii) Mine examiner certificates to qualified
7 applicants desiring to work as a mine examiner in a sur-
8 face mine.

9 (b) To obtain a surface mine foreman certificate, an
10 applicant shall:

11 (i) Be at least twenty-three (23) years of
12 age;

13 (ii) Have at least three (3) years of experi-
14 ence in the type of mine in which he desires to work;

15 (iii) Pass an examination under W.S. 30-3-305.

16 (c) To obtain a surface mine examiner certificate,
17 an applicant shall:

18 (i) Have at least two (2) years of experience
19 in the type of mine in which he desires to work;

1 (ii) Pass an examination under W.S. 30-3-305.

(d) Education shall be credited toward the experience requirements in paragraphs (b)(ii) and (c)(i) of this section in the same manner as under W.S. 30-3-307. The examining board may issue certificates under this section to persons certified to perform the same duties by the examining board of another state with which Wyoming has a reciprocal agreement.

9 (e) Applicants for certificates under this section
10 are subject to the fees in W.S. 30-3-310 and 30-3-311.
11 The inspector of mines may issue temporary permits to
12 applicants for certificates under this section under W.S.
13 30-3-309. Certificates issued under this section are
14 subject to revocation and replacement under W.S. 30-3-310.

(f) Nothing in this section requires certification of mine foremen, assistant mine foremen, safety engineers or mine examiners in surface mines.

18 Section 2. This act is effective May 27, 1983.

1 (a) The examining board may issue mine foreman
2 certificates to qualified applicants desiring to work as a
3 mine foreman, assistant mine foreman or safety engineer in
4 a surface mine.

5 (b) To obtain a surface mine foreman certificate, an
6 applicant shall:

7 (i) Be at least twenty-three (23) years of
8 age;

9 (ii) Have at least three (3) years of experi-
10 ence in the type of mine in which he desires to work;

11 (iii) Pass an examination under W.S. 30-3-305.

12 (c) Education shall be credited toward the experi-
13 ence requirement in paragraph (b)(ii) of this section in
14 the same manner as under W.S. 30-3-307. The examining
15 board may issue certificates under this section to persons
16 certified to perform the same duties by the examining
17 board of another state with which Wyoming has a reciprocal
18 agreement.

20 are subject to the fees in W.S. 30-3-310 and 30-3-311.
21 The inspector of mines may issue temporary permits to

3 subject to revocation and replacement under W.S. 30-3-310.

4 (e) Nothing in this section requires certification
5 of mine foremen, assistant mine foremen, safety engineers
6 or mine examiners in surface mines.

7 Section 2. This act is effective May 27, 1983.
