COUNTY COURTS-EXPUNGEMENT OF JUVENILE RECORDS

Original House Bill No. 40

AN ACT relating to juvenile offenders; authorizing the expungement of a minor's record of conviction in county court in the same manner as provided for expungement in juvenile and municipal court; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 14-6-241 by creating a new subsection (c) is amended to read:

14-6-241. Expungement of records in juvenile, municipal and county courts.

(c) The record of a minor convicted of a misdemeanor in county court may be expunged in the same manner as provided in subsection (a) of this section by petition to the county court.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1997.
