

**CHAPTER 53**

**COUNTY COURTS-EXPUNGEMENT OF JUVENILE RECORDS**

Original House Bill No. 40

AN ACT relating to juvenile offenders; authorizing the expungement of a minor's record of conviction in county court in the same manner as provided for expungement in juvenile and municipal court; and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 14-6-241 by creating a new subsection (c) is amended to read:

**14-6-241. Expungement of records in juvenile, municipal and county courts.**

(c) The record of a minor convicted of a misdemeanor in county court may be expunged in the same manner as provided in subsection (a) of this section by petition to the county court.

**Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 1997.
