

8	Section 1. W.S. 18-6-303 is amended to read:

18-6-303. Care of prisoners; audit of expenses.

- 1 (a) The sheriff shall provide separate rooms for the 2 sexes except when lawfully married, AND THEN AT THE 3 SHERIFF'S SOLE DISCRETION, and shall supply prisoners with 4 bread, -meat, WHOLESOME FOOD AND drink, bed--elething, 5 frames and sacks--fer-beds BEDDING, sanitary facilities, 6 suitable means for warming the jail, -- necessary -- medical 7 attendance -- and -nursing and such other necessities for the 8 welfare of the prisoners. as-the-grand-jury-may-recommend-Expenses thereof shall be audited and settled by the 9
- 11 (b) THE SHERIFF SHALL ARRANGE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION
  12 OF MEDICAL CARE REASONABLY REQUIRED BY PRISONERS COMMITTED

- 15 PROCEEDINGS TO COLLECT FROM THE PRISONER ANY AMOUNTS SO
