AN ACT to protect persons in automobiles and the traveling public on the railroads from certain dangers at railway crossings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That, whereas, many accidents happen at railroad crossings by collisions of trains with automobiles, endangering the lives of persons in such automobiles, and also endangering the lives of the traveling public upon the railroad trains:

Therefore, for the purpose of preventing such collisions, it shall be the duty of every person driving an automobile over a railroad crossing, to stop such automobile at a safe distance from such crossing and look and listen before attempting to cross the railroad tracks, and it shall likewise be the duty of the persons in such automobile to require the driver to stop as aforesaid.

Section 2. This act shall effect and be in force from and after its passage.
