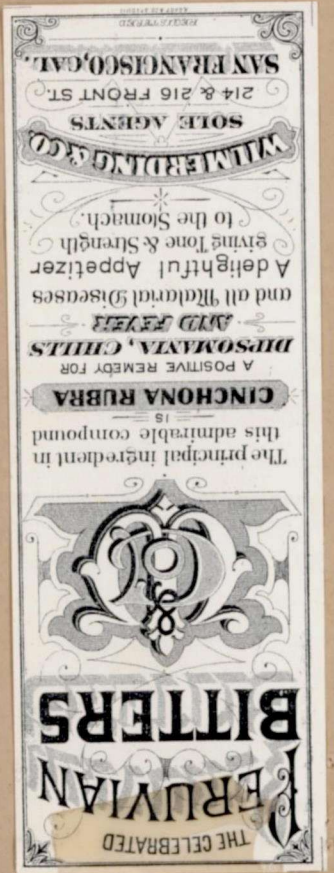
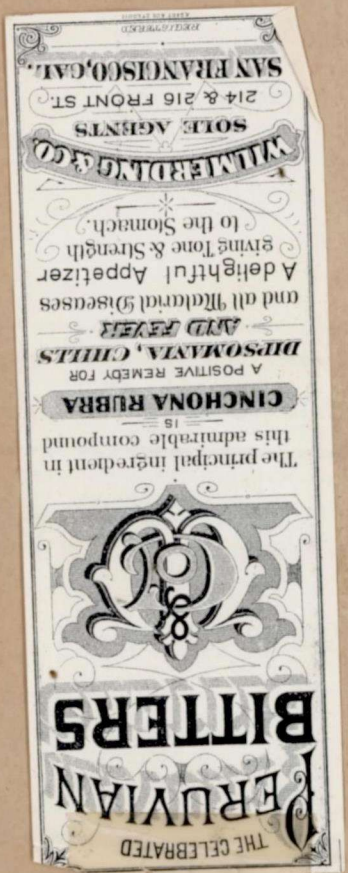

provided, and they hereby constitute and  
appoint C. W. M. Smith Esq. of San Francisco  
aforesaid, their Attorney in this matter  
with full power of substitution and re-  
vocation, and to transact all business  
connected therewith.

## Specification.

To all whom it may concern.

Be it known that we, G. Blute Wilmerding and John Tuthill Haviland domiciled in the United States, and both residing at San Francisco, and doing business in San Francisco, in the County of San Francisco, and State of California under the firm name of Wilmerding and Company, have adopted for our use a Trade-Mark for a tonic or stomach Bitters, of which the following is a specification.

Our Trade-Mark consists of the words "Peruvian Bitters", these words have generally been arranged as shown in the accompanying fac-simile upon a white or tinted field and surrounded by a border; beneath these words are stamped or printed the letters "W. & Co" in a monogram, and interwoven, being an abbreviation of the name of the firm.

This monogram is engraved upon a field or escutcheon having fanciful borders or sides as

But the escutcheon may be omitted, or some other device substituted for it, and the borders may be changed at pleasure or omitted altogether, without materially changing the character of our Trade-Mark, the essential features of which are the words, "Peruvian Bitters", and the abbreviated letters or characters, "W. & Co" in monogram.

This Trade-Mark we have used in our business for the space of five years last past.

The class of Merchandise to which our Trade-Mark is appropriated is "Cordials", and the particular goods comprised in said class upon which we use our said Trade-Mark is a cordial for the relief of those who are afflicted with Dyspepsia, Chills and Fever and other malarial diseases.

We have been accustomed to stamp or print it in

the glass of the bottles; to print it upon labels, wrappers and circulars and afterwards paste the labels upon the bottles. Also to stamp or brand it upon the boxes and packages containing the said "Peruvian Bitters".
