## A BILL

FOR

AN ACT to amend Section 2857 of the Compiled Statutes of Wyoming 1910 relating to Billiard Table License.

Be it enacted by the legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. That Section 2857 Compiled Statutes of Wyoming.

1910, be and the same is, hereby amended and re-enacted so as to read as

follows:

keeping a Billiard table, or any table used for pool, bagatelle, or any game not prohibited by the laws of this state, and not otherwise specially provided for, when such table is not exclusively for the private use of the owner and his family, shall be required to pay a license of five dollars per quarter year on each such table owned or kept; for each nine or ten pin or bowling alley, the owner, lessee or manager thereof, shall be required to pay a license of ten dollars per quarter year. The license money provided for in this section shall be collected in the manner provided for the collection of other county licenses.

where such table or tables are located, and be it further enacted that each violation of the clause in this section relating to minors shall constitute a misdemeaner on the part of the owner or manager of such table or tables and shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars or each offense.
