

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 9-230 through 9-237; and to repeal
2 W.S. 9-238 through 9-240 relating to the intergovern-
3 mental cooperation commission; establishing the commis-
4 sion; defining its membership; designating the commission
5 as the official organization to promote intergovernmental
6 cooperation; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 9-230 through 9-237 are amended to
9 read:

10 9-230. Established; composition; ex officio members;
11 chairman.

12 (a) There is hereby established the Wyoming commis-
13 sion on intergovernmental cooperations--~~this--~~commission
14 ~~shall--be~~ composed of THE FOLLOWING fifteen (15) regular
15 members; ~~v-namely:~~

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1 (i) The five (5) members of the senate commit-
2 tee on intergovernmental cooperation;

3 (ii) The five (5) members of the house commit-
4 tee on intergovernmental cooperation; and

5 (iii) The five (5) members of the governor's
6 committee on intergovernmental cooperation.

7 **(b)** The governor, the president of the senate and
8 the speaker of the house of representatives ~~shall-be-ex-~~
9 ~~officio-honorary-non-voting-members~~ ARE EX OFFICIO NON-
10 VOTING MEMBERS of ~~this~~ THE commission. The chairman of the
11 ~~governor's---committee---on---intergovernmental---cooperation~~
12 ~~shall-be-ex-officio-chairman-of-this~~ commission SHALL BE
13 ELECTED FROM THE APPOINTED MEMBERS.

14 9-231. Senate committee. There is hereby established
15 a standing committee of the WYOMING senate ~~of-this-state~~
16 ~~to-be-officially~~ known as the senate committee on inter-
17 governmental cooperation, and to consist of five (5) sena-
18 tors. The members and the chairman of this committee shall
19 be designated in the same manner as ~~is-customary-in-the~~
20 ~~case-of~~ members and chairmen of other standing committees
21 of the senate. In addition to the regular members, the
22 president of the senate ~~shall-be-ex-officio~~ IS an honorary
23 ~~non-voting~~ EX OFFICIO NONVOTING member of this committee.

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1 9-232. House committee. There is hereby established
2 a ~~similar~~ standing committee of the WYOMING house of
3 representatives ~~of this state, to be officially~~ known as
4 the house committee on intergovernmental cooperation, and
5 to consist of five (5) members of the house of repre-
6 sentatives. The members and the chairman of this committee
7 shall be designated in the same manner as ~~is customary in~~
8 ~~the case of the~~ members and chairmen of other standing
9 committees of the house of representatives. In addition to
10 the regular members, the speaker of the house of repre-
11 sentatives ~~shall be ex-officio~~ IS an honorary-non-voting
12 EX OFFICIO NONVOTING member of this committee.

13 9-233. Governor's committee. There is hereby estab-
14 lished a committee of administrative officials and
15 employees of this state ~~to be officially~~ known as the
16 governor's committee on intergovernmental cooperation, and
17 to consist of five (5) members. Its members shall be ~~the~~
18 budget director or the corresponding official of this
19 state, ~~ex-officio~~ the attorney general, ~~ex-officio~~ the
20 chief of the staff of the state planning board or the cor-
21 responding official of this state, ~~ex-officio~~ and two (2)
22 other administrative officials or employees ~~to be~~ desig-
23 nated by the governor. If there is uncertainty as to the
24 identity of any of the ~~ex-officio~~ EX OFFICIO members of

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1 this committee, the governor shall determine the question,
2 ~~v--and--his-determination-and-designation-shall-be-conclu-~~
3 ~~sive.~~ The governor shall appoint one (1) of the five (5)
4 members of this committee as its chairman. In addition to
5 the regular members, the governor ~~shall-be--ex-officio~~ IS
6 an ~~honorary-non-voting~~ EX OFFICIO NONVOTING member of this
7 committee.

8 9-234. When legislative committees to function;
9 terms of members; to constitute senate council and house
10 council of the American legislators' association. The said
11 standing committee of the senate and the said standing
12 committee of the house of representatives shall function
13 during the regular sessions of the legislature and also
14 during the interim periods between such sessions.† Their
15 members shall serve until their successors are designated.
16 ~~†--and--they--shall-respectively-constitute-for-this-state~~
17 ~~the-senate-council--and--house--council--of--the--American~~
18 ~~legislators'--association.~~ The incumbency of each adminis-
19 trative member of this commission shall extend until the
20 ~~first--day--of~~ February 1 next following his appointment,
21 and thereafter until his successor is appointed.

22 9-235. Function of commission. ~~It shall be the func-~~
23 ~~tion of this~~

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1 (a) THE commission SHALL:

2 (1) To carry forward the participation of this
3 state as a member of the council of state governments; *

4 (2) (iii) To Encourage and assist the legislative,
5 executive, administrative and judicial officials and
6 employees of this state to develop and maintain friendly
7 contact by correspondence, by conference, and otherwise,
8 with officials and employees of the other states, of the
9 federal government, and of local units of government; *

10 (3) (iii) To Endeavor to advance cooperation
11 between this state and other units of government whenever
12 ~~it seems advisable to do so by formulating proposals for~~
13 ~~and by facilitating:~~ (a) ~~The adoption of compacts,~~
14 (b) ~~The enactment of uniform or reciprocal statutes,~~
15 (c) ~~The adoption of uniform or reciprocal administrative~~
16 ~~rules and regulations,~~ (d) ~~The informal cooperation of~~
17 ~~governmental offices with one another,~~ (e) ~~The personal~~
18 ~~cooperation of governmental officials and employees with~~
19 ~~one another, individually,~~ (f) ~~The interchange and clear-~~
20 ~~ance of research and information, and (g) Any other suit-~~
21 ~~able process.~~ (4) ~~In short,~~ to AND do all such acts as
22 will, in the opinion of this commission, enable this state
23 to do its part or more than its part in forming a more

1 perfect union among the various governments in the United
2 States and in developing the council of state governments
3 for that purpose.

4 9-236. Delegations and committees; advisory boards.

5 The commission shall establish such delegations and OR
6 committees as it deems advisable ~~in order that they may~~
7 TO confer and formulate proposals concerning effective
8 means to secure intergovernmental harmony ~~and may per-~~
9 ~~form other functions for the commission in obedience to~~
10 ~~its decisions.~~ Subject to the approval of the commission,
11 the member or members of each such delegation or committee
12 shall be appointed by the chairman of the commission.
13 State officials or employees who are not members of the
14 commission on intergovernmental cooperation may be
15 appointed as members of any such delegation or committee,
16 but private citizens holding no governmental position in
17 this state shall not be eligible. The commission may pro-
18 vide such other rules as it considers appropriate concern-
19 ing the membership and the functioning of any such dele-
20 gation or committee. The commission may provide for advi-
21 sory boards for itself and for its various delegations and
22 committees, and may authorize private citizens to serve on
23 such boards.

24 9-237. Reports to governor; per diem and expenses of

1 ~~members and appointees; employment of secretary and ste-~~
2 ~~nographer; other expenses, etc.~~ The commission shall, as
3 required by section W.S. 9-21₂ of the statutes, report to
4 the governor. ~~Its members and the members of all~~
5 ~~delegations and committees which it establishes except~~
6 ~~those on state salaries receive \$12 per day for the time~~
7 ~~actually and necessarily employed and shall be reimbursed~~
8 ~~for expenses in accordance with section 9-13 of the stat-~~
9 ~~utes.~~ LEGISLATIVE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL RECEIVE
10 LEGISLATIVE SALARY, PER DIEM AND TRAVEL ALLOWANCE AND
11 OTHER MEMBERS SHALL RECEIVE PER DIEM AND TRAVEL ALLOWANCE
12 IN THE MANNER AND AMOUNT AUTHORIZED BY LAW FOR STATE
13 EMPLOYEES. The commission may employ a secretary and a
14 stenographer, it may incur such other expenses as may be
15 necessary for the proper performance of its duties, and it
16 may, by contributions to the council of state governments,
17 participate with other states in maintaining the council's
18 district and central secretariats, and its other govern-
19 mental services.

20 Section 2. W.S. 9-238 through 9-240 are repealed.

21 Section 3. This act is effective May 27, 1977.
