8 Section 1. W.S. 12-6-101(b) (intro) is amended to  
 9 read:

10 12-6-101. SALE OR POSSESSION PROHIBITED; WHEN POSSES-  
 11 SION UNLAWFUL; PUBLIC DRUNKENNESS; FALSIFICATION OF IDEN-  
 12 TIFICATION; PENALTY; PRIMA FACIE IDENTIFICATION AS

**NO SIGNIFICANT FISCAL OR PERSONNEL IMPACT AT STATE LEVEL**

1 DEFENSE.

2 (b) Any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years  
3 who has any alcoholic or malt beverage in his possession,  
4 who has consumed any alcoholic or malt beverage or a con-  
5 trolled substance or who is drunk or under the influence  
6 of alcoholic liquor, malt beverages or a controlled sub-  
7 stance on any street or highway or in any public place is  
8 guilty of a misdemeanor. This subsection does not apply to  
9 possession of alcoholic or malt beverages by a person  
10 under the age of twenty-one (21) years:

11 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon  
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-  
14 tution.
