## A BILL for

1 AN ACT to provide for the registration of snowmobiles; payment of  
2 registration fees to the county treasurer; division of  
3 registration fees between county and state; numbering of  
4 such snowmobiles; a penalty for violation; and providing  
5 an effective date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

7 Section 1. Definitions.

8 (a) Snowmobile means any mechanically driven vehicle of a  
9 type which utilizes sled type runners, or skis, or any endless  
10 belt tread and/or combination of these, designated primarily for  
11 operation over snow.

12 Section 2. Every person, firm, corporation, co-operative or  
13 partnership who shall own a snowmobile used within the State of  
14 Wyoming shall, for each such snowmobile file or cause to be filed  
15 each calendar year in the office of the county treasurer where  
16 the owner of such snowmobile resides, or in case of ownership by  
17 a non-resident of this state, in any county of the State, an  
18 application for registration of such snowmobile which shall be  
19 in writing and signed by the owner of such snowmobile or his,  
20 her or its duly authorized agent, which application shall state  
21 (1) the name and address of the owner (2) the name of the applicant  
22 (3) a description of the snowmobile, including make, model and any  
23 identifying serial numbers located on such snowmobile, except that

1 non-resident is exempt from this registration for fifteen days from  
2 the time of entry to the state.

3 Section 3. The owner of such snowmobile shall, upon the filing  
4 of said application, pay to the county treasurer, in cash, money order,  
5 certified check or bank draft, a registration fee as hereinafter  
6 designated.

7 Section 4. (a) The annual registration fees shall be the sum  
8 of five dollars (\$5.00) for such snowmobile.

9 (b) Snowmobiles are hereby exempt from any and all ad valorem  
10 taxes.

11 (c) The county treasurer shall forward to the Recreation Commission  
12 of the State of Wyoming, sixty (60) percent of the above stated regis-  
13 tration fees as provided for in Section 4 and shall credit to the  
14 General County Fund in which county such fees are collected, the  
15 remaining forty (40) percent of such registration fees.

16 (d) It shall be the duty of the Recreation Commission of  
17 Wyoming, to furnish sufficient quantity of numbered decals on  
18 numbered plates and keep full and complete records of all such  
19 snowmobiles.

20 Section 5. That said fees as above stated shall be paid  
21 before the expiration of sixteen (16) days after acquiring owner-  
22 ship of a snowmobile. Upon receipt of the registration fee, as  
23 above described, the county treasurer shall issue to such applicant  
24 a certificate of registration, setting forth the facts in the  
25 application, together with a numbered decal or plate which numbered  
26 decal or plate shall bear the distinctive number assigned to such  
27 snowmobile which shall at all times be prominently displayed on said  
28 snowmobile.

29 Section 6. In the event of loss, mutilation or destruction of  
30 any registration certificate, the owner of such snowmobile may  
31 obtain from the county treasurer of the county in which such  
32 snowmobile originally registered for a fee of one dollar (\$1.00),

1 a duplicate of the registration certificate. It shall be unlawful  
2 for any person to willfully alter or mutilate any registration  
3 certificate.

4 Section 7. Every certificate and number awarded pursuant to  
5 this Act shall continue in full force and effect for a period of  
6 one (1) year and shall expire on December 31, each year, and shall  
7 be renewed annually and in the same manner and upon the payment of  
8 the same fees as provided in this Act for original registration, such  
9 renewals to take effect on the first day of January of each year;  
10 provided that the use of license plates or decals, issued during any  
11 calendar year is hereby authorized and legalized until and including  
12 the first day of February of the next succeeding year.

13 Section 8. The provisions of this Act shall not apply to such  
14 snowmobiles whose owner is the United States.

15 Section 9. The violation of any of the provisions of this  
16 Act shall be deemed a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not less  
17 than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) and not exceeding one hundred  
18 dollars (\$100.00).
