1 AN ACT to create W.S. 22-6-130 relating to elections; pro-
2 viding for a preference vote on the use of optional sales
3 and use tax revenue; specifying the form of the question;

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 22-6-130 is created to read:

8 22-6-130. Question of preference for use of sales
9 and use tax revenue to be placed on ballot; form; prefer-
10 ence expressed is nonbinding.

1 (a) Upon written direction of the board of county
2 commissioners, the county clerk shall place on the ballot
3 at an election for the imposition of the optional sales
4 and use tax or at a general election for the continuance
5 of those taxes the question of how the optional sales and
6 use tax revenue shall be used in both the incorporated and
7 unincorporated areas of the county.

8 (b) The question shall be submitted in substantially
9 the following form:

10 "Shall the revenue from the optional sales and use
11 tax be used in the year(s) (specify year or years)
12 for the following purposes?"
