BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 11-105, Wyoming Statutes 1957,

6

is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

The secretary-treasurer of each predatory animal district

8

shall keep a complete and accurate record of the proceedings

9

of said board. ~~and shall prepare vouchers for all expenditures~~

10

~~from the funds of his district, and all such vouchers shall~~

11

~~be approved in writing by the board president or any other~~

12

~~director of the district. All salaries, expenses or bounties~~

13

~~shall be paid from the predatory animal district fund of the~~

14

~~district by the county treasurer on presentation of such proper~~

15

~~voucher.~~

ALL SALARIES, EXPENSES OR BOUNTIES SHALL BE PAID FROM

17

THE PREDATORY ANIMAL DISTRICT FUND OF THE DISTRICT BY THE

18

SECRETARY-TREASURER AND RECORDED IN A CASH BOOK.

19

ALL EXPENDITURES OF THE DISTRICT SHALL BE SUPPORTED BY

1 PROPERLY APPROVED VOUCHERS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS IN
2 WRITING SIGNED BY THE BOARD PRESIDENT AND ANY OTHER
3 DIRECTOR.

4 THE COUNTY TREASURER SHALL ISSUE MONTHLY WARRANTS
5 TO THE PREDATORY ANIMAL DISTRICT FOR THE TOTAL SUM OF THE
6 MONIES COLLECTED IN SAID COUNTY FOR THE PREDATORY ANIMAL
7 DISTRICT.
