

**Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission
Supervisor's Report to Commission – Tom Kropatsch
August 2021**



APDs:

The number of APDs received in July 2021 was 419 – a decrease of 19 from the month before.

RIG COUNT:

According to Enverus (Drill Info) the rig count report for the week of August 9 is 15.

Count by Counties:

Campbell – 3

Converse – 5

Laramie – 3

Natrona - 1

Sublette – 2

Sweetwater - 1

The Wyoming rig count this time last year was 1 according to Baker Hughes' historical records.

MONTHLY PRODUCTION: Wyoming oil production for May 2021 was 7,154,034 BO at the time of this report – an increase in production by approximately 41% from this time last year.

Wyoming gas production for May 2021 was 116,873,915 MCF at the time of this report - a decrease in production by approximately 4% from this time last year.

BONDS:

The end of July 2021 bond report is as follows:

Total bond amount was \$251,180,717. Idle wells bond was \$184,273,748 which is approximately 73% of the total bond amount.

FLARE:

The volume of approved flared gas for May 2021 from 10 wells was 77,900 MCF total.

However, the actual flared volume of gas for the same time period was 32,104 MCF total; which is 41.2% percent of the approved volume.

There is currently 6 oil wells flaring in excess of the 60 MCFD limit, in accordance with WOGCC Rule Chapter 3, Section 39(b); that requires Supervisor or Commission approval

ORPHAN WELL UPDATE:

For the month of July, the WOGCC plugged 70 wells. A total of 465 have been plugged for 2021 at the time of this report. So far this year the WOGCC has completed 5 projects, 6 ongoing projects, 1 project about to begin, and 3 projects in the planning stages.
