## Enrolled Act No. 6, Senate

TWENTY-FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 108-1202, Wyoming Revised Statutes, 1931, defining the objects of The Wyoming General Hospital and directing the establishment and maintenance of a training school for nurses therein.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 108-1202, Wyoming Revised Statutes, 1931, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 108-1202. The object of said hospital shall be to provide sustenance, care and medical and surgical attention for all miners who shall become disabled or incapecitated to labor while working in the mines of the state, and who shall be in need of such sustenance, care or medical or surgical attention, and to such other persons as may be admitted, under the laws, rules and regulations established for the government thereof, and a school for the training of nurses shall be established and maintained as a part of said hospital.
