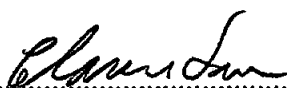

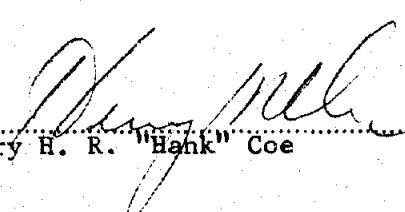

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

5 Section 1. W.S. 8-3-115 is created to read:

6 8-3-115. State reptile. The eastern short-horned liz-
7 ard (*Phrynosoma douglassi brevirostre* (Girad)) commonly
8 known as the horned toad, is the state reptile of Wyoming.

1 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-
4 tution.
