

1 AN ACT to create W.S. 31-5-962; and to amend W.S. 31-5-919
2 relating to vehicle equipment; prohibiting the modifica-
3 tion of certain vehicles by increasing the height of the
4 bumper; requiring bumpers; authorizing the display of flu-
5 orescent orange flags on oversize loads; and providing for
6 an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 31-5-962 is created to read:

9 31-5-962. Vehicle bumpers and modifications; excep-
10 tions. No person shall operate a passenger car as defined

1 in W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xv)(F) or a pickup truck, except a
2 four-wheel drive vehicle, upon a public street or highway
3 without a bumper, or other energy absorption system if the
4 distance from the ground to a load-bearing member of the
5 horizontal bumper bar is greater than twenty-two (22)
6 inches. This section does not apply to commercial vehi-
7 cles or with an unaltered and undamaged stock bumper or
8 energy absorption system supplied by the manufacturer.

9 Section 2. W.S. 31-5-919 is amended to read:

10 31-5-919. Lamps, reflectors and flags on projecting
11 loads. Whenever the load upon any vehicle extends to the
12 rear four (4) feet or more beyond the bed or body of the
13 vehicle there shall be displayed at the extreme rear end
14 of the load, at the times specified in W.S. 31-5-910, two
15 (2) red lamps, two (2) red reflectors located so as to
16 indicate maximum width, and on each side one (1) red lamp
17 located so as to indicate maximum overhang. There shall be
18 displayed at all other times on any vehicle having a load
19 which extends beyond its sides or more than four (4) feet
20 beyond its rear, red OR FLUORESCENT ORANGE flags, not less
21 than twelve (12) inches square, marking the extremities of
22 the load, at each point where a lamp would otherwise be
23 required by this section. Lamps and reflectors required in

1 this section shall comply with the regulations of the
2 superintendent.

3 Section 3. This act is effective June 11, 1986.

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

5 Section 1. W.S. 31-5-919 is amended to read:

6 31-5-919. Lamps, reflectors and flags on projecting
7 loads. Whenever the load upon any vehicle extends to the
8 rear four (4) feet or more beyond the bed or body of the
9 vehicle there shall be displayed at the extreme rear end
10 of the load, at the times specified in W.S. 31-5-910, two

1 (2) red lamps, two (2) red reflectors located so as to
2 indicate maximum width, and on each side one (1) red lamp
3 located so as to indicate maximum overhang. There shall be
4 displayed at all other times on any vehicle having a load
5 which extends beyond its sides or more than four (4) feet
6 beyond its rear, red OR FLUORESCENT ORANGE flags, not less
7 than twelve (12) inches square, marking the extremities of
8 the load, at each point where a lamp would otherwise be
9 required by this section. Lamps and reflectors required in
10 this section shall comply with the regulations of the
11 superintendent.

12 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-
15 tution.
