This matter is before the Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) upon the filing of Metropolitan Telecommunication of Wyoming, Inc. d/b/a MetTel (MetTel or the Company) for authority to revise its Local Exchange Service tariff, Wyoming Tariff No. 2.

The Commission, having reviewed the price schedules, its files regarding MetTel, applicable telecommunications law, and otherwise being fully advised in the premises, FINDS and CONCLUDES:

- 1. MetTel is a telecommunications company as defined by Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-103(a)(xi), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-401.
- 2. On February 1, 2021, MetTel filed its Application requesting authority to revise its Local Exchange Service tariff, Wyoming Tariff No. 2. MetTel proposes several resale price service increases. As a reseller, the rates MetTel charges are dependent upon the underlying Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier (ILEC) service charges. MetTel proposes to increase the Flat Rate for Standard Business Local Exchange Service Monthly Recurring Charges for Individual Line and Multiline from \$26.10 to \$27.11 a month, and to increase the Measured Rate from \$21.32 to \$22.14 a month. In addition, MetTel proposes increases to Business PBX Trunk Service, Direct Inward Dialing Service, and various Optional Calling Features.
- 3. MetTel's tariff filing came before the Commission for consideration pursuant to due notice at the Commission's Open Meeting on March 11, 2021. John Rossi, Consultant-Product Management, and Susan Salmansohn, Executive Director, appeared for the Company. Mr. Rossi stated the Company proposes increased rates for business services, including business lines, Business PBX trunks, Digital Centrex Service, some customer calling services and adjusted the discount rates for business line customers because of service charge increases by the ILEC. Commission Staff recommended approval of the price schedule revisions. The Commission directed MetTel to review its regulatory practices and follow-up with Staff to determine if the competitive statutes apply to the Company.
- 4. Based on the price schedule filing and the recommendations of Commission Staff, the Commission finds and concludes that MetTel's Application is in the public interest and should be approved.

5. The Commission directs that public notice in this matter be in the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) approved the Application of Metropolitan Telecommunication of Wyoming, Inc. d/b/a MetTel (MetTel) for revisions to its Local Exchange Service tariff, Wyoming Tariff No. 2., subject to notice, protest, intervention, refund, change, further investigation, opportunity for hearing and further order of the Commission. As a reseller, the rates MetTel charges are dependent upon what the underlying Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier charges for service. MetTel proposes to increase the Standard Business Local Exchange Service Monthly Recurring Charges for Individual Line and Multiline from \$26.10 to \$27.11 a month and to increase the Measured Rate from \$21.32 to \$22.14 a month. In addition, the Company proposes increases to Business PBX Trunk Service, Direct Inward Dialing Service and various Optional Calling Features.
