Enrolled Act No. 5, House of Representatives SIXTEENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING

AN ACT appropriating money for the regulation and control of the water of the Little Snake River near the Town of Baggs, Wyoming.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING.

Section 1. The sum of five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to be expended for the purpose of regulating and controlling the Little Snake River at points in Section 4, Township 12 North, Renge 91 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, and thereby afford necessary protection for the Town of Beggs, Wyoming, and for the public bridge across the Little Snake River in the vicinity. The State Engineer shall have general charge of the proposed work and the expenditure of money therefor.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
