A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to legislative grants for initiatives in
2 public education; authorizing school districts to submit
3 proposals for programs for education initiatives to the
4 legislature's interim committee on education; providing
5 procedures; providing for planning grants; providing an
6 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1.

9 (a) Not later than August 1, 1989, each Wyoming

1 school district board of trustees shall submit one (1) or
2 more proposals for a legislative grant to fund a project
3 for innovation or improvement in public education to the
4 Joint Senate Health, Education and Welfare and House Edu-
5 cation Interim Committee of the legislature. Projects
6 should promote the creation of new, different and improved
7 educational opportunities in elementary or secondary
8 schools, should supplement and not supplant existing
9 courses and curriculum and may include but are not limited
10 to:

11 (i) Staff development and improvement programs
12 such as performance incentives, awards for excellence,
13 professional training and development activities and per-
14 formance evaluation programs;

15 (ii) Curriculum development activities such as
16 core curriculum development, textbook review, programs to
17 develop critical or creative thinking, programs involving
18 the private sector, initiatives to develop moral and ethi-
19 cal values and behavior, disciplinary programs, programs
20 to improve conduct and encourage good work habits and
21 parental and family training;

22 (iii) Operational initiatives such as changes
23 in class schedules, school day, week, month or year calen-

1 dar and scheduling of extracurricular activities;

2 (iv) Programs for gifted and talented stu-
3 dents, students who need remedial work or other students
4 with special or unique needs.

5 (b) Not later than April 1, 1989, the department of
6 education shall pay to each school district one dollar
7 (\$1.00) for each average daily membership of the district
8 for the 1988-1989 school year as defined in W.S.
9 21-13-101(a)(i) and as determined by the department to be
10 used for planning and development of the proposals. No
11 district shall receive less than five hundred dollars
12 (\$500.00) under this subsection. The planning process for
13 each proposal shall include at least one (1) conference
14 with teachers in the district and at least one (1) addi-
15 tional hearing for public comment from taxpayers in the
16 district. The term of the project in each proposal shall
17 be at least one (1) and not less than three (3) academic
18 years. The school district board of trustees shall
19 advise, in writing, each person attending a conference of
20 the reasons for acceptance or rejection of any proposal
21 offered at the conferences.

22 (c) The Joint Senate Education, Health and Welfare
23 and House Education Interim Committee shall select not

1 less than ten (10) and not more than sixteen (16) propos-
2 als for consideration by the 1990 legislature. The Com-
3 mittee shall propose legislation during the 1990 legisla-
4 ture to fund not less than five (5) and not more than
5 eight (8) of these proposals for their entire term. The
6 Committee shall disclose proposals selected for consider-
7 ation but not included in the legislation in a report to
8 the 1990 legislature describing all proposals selected for
9 consideration. Funds for proposals shall be distributed
10 by the department of education.

11 Section 2.

12 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund to
13 the department of education one hundred twenty-five thou-
14 sand dollars (\$125,000.00) or as much thereof as is neces-
15 sary to implement Section 1(b) of this act.

16 (b) There is appropriated from the foundation pro-
17 gram account within the earmarked revenue fund to the
18 department of education three million dollars
19 (\$3,000,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to
20 implement Section 1(c) of this act.

1 Section 3. Section 2(b) of this act is effective
2 April 1, 1990. The balance of this act is effective imme-
3 diately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill
4 to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the
5 Wyoming Constitution.




