

Enrolled Act No. 21, House of Representatives

SEVENTY-FIRST SESSION OF THE
STATE LEGISLATURE OF
THE STATE OF WYOMING

AN ACT authorizing the trustees of the University of Wyoming to issue bonds and other securities; stating the purposes for which the securities may be issued; directing that the construction of buildings be done by contract based on competitive bidding except as otherwise provided.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. The trustees of the University of Wyoming, a body corporate of the State of Wyoming, and constituting the governing body of the state university called the University of Wyoming, in addition to other balances or monies authorized by Chapter 136, Session Laws of Wyoming 1969, for the purposes herein set forth, are hereby authorized to issue bonds or other securities, in accordance with the provisions of the University Securities Law, in a total principal amount of not exceeding One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), at any time or from time to time hereafter as the trustees may determine, but not after five years from the effective date of this act, to defray wholly or in part the costs of any one or more, or all, as the trustees may determine, of the following purposes:

To construct, otherwise acquire, furnish and equip:

- (a) a physical education facility
- (b) a plant science laboratory
- (c) an addition to the law school building
- (d) a nuclear accelerator building.

Nothing herein contained, however, shall be construed as preventing the trustees from

funding, refunding or reissuing any securities thereof at any time as provided in the _____
University Securities Law. _____

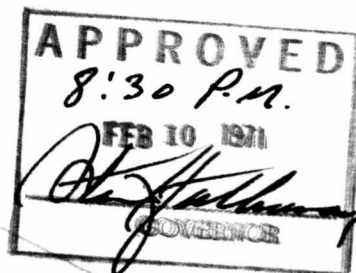
Section 2. (a) Except as herein otherwise provided, the work of constructing the _____
various buildings shall be done by contract based on competitive bidding. Notice of call for _____
bids shall be for such period of time and in such manner as the trustees may determine, and _____
the trustees shall have the power to reject any and all bids, to waive any irregularities, _____
and to readvertise for bids as they consider proper. _____

(b) The landscaping around any authorized construction, the preparation of _____
parking lots and similar facilities in connection with any of the purposes, and any _____
furnishing or equipment, and any reconditioning, renovating, remodeling, refurnishing and _____
re-equipping of any buildings, structures or other facilities, in the discretion of the _____
trustees, may be done in whole or in part by university personnel or by contract let on _____
competitive bidding. _____

Section 3. The powers conferred by this Act shall be in addition and supplemental _____
to, and not in substitution for, and the limitations imposed by this Act shall not affect _____
the powers conferred by, any other law. _____
