STATE LEGISLATURE OF

AN ACT authorizing the trustees of the University of Wyoming to issue bonds and other securities; stating the purposes for which the securities may be issued; directing that the construction of buildings be done by contract based on competitive bidding except as otherwise provided.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

State of Wyoming, and constituting the governing hody of the state university called the University of Wyoming, in addition to other balances or monies authorized by Chapter 136,

Session Laws of Wyoming 1969, for the purposes herein set forth, are hereby authorized to issue bonds or other securities, in accordance with the provisions of the University Securities is a total principal amount of not exceeding One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), at any sine or from time to time hereafter as the trustees may determine, but not after five the more, or a 1, as the trustees may determine, of the following purposes:

To construct, otherwise acquire, furnish and equip:

- (a) a physical education facility___
- (b) a plant science laboratory____
- (c) an addition to the law school building
- (d) a nuclear accelerator building.

funding, refunding or reissuing any securities thereof at any time as provided in the
University Securities Law.
Section 2. (a) Except as herein otherwise provided, the work of constructing the
various buildings shall be done by contract based on competitive bidding. Notice of call for_
bids shall be for such period of time and in such manner as the trustees may determine, and
the trustees shall have the power to reject any and all bids, to waive any irregularities,
and to readvertise for bids as they consider proper.
(b) The landscaping around any authorized construction, the preparation of
parking lots and similar facilities in connection with any of the purposes, and any
furnishing or equipment, and any reconditioning, renovating, remodeling, refurnishing and
re-equipping of any buildings, structures or other facilities, in the discretion of the
trustees, may be done in whole or in part by university personnel or by contract let on
competitive bidding
Section 3. The powers conferred by this Act shall be in addition and supplemental
to, and not in substitution for, and the limitations imposed by this Act shall not affect
the powers conferred by, any other law.
