A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the Constitu-
2 tion of the State of Wyoming by amending Article 14,
3 Section 2, to delete the provision entitling sheriffs to
4 receive fees in addition to salary for services rendered
5 in civil cases.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
7 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
8 separately, concurring therein:

9 Section 1. The following amendment to Article 14,
10 Section 2, of the Wyoming Constitution is proposed for
11 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
12 next general election for approval or rejection, to become
13 valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a
14 majority of the electors. The amendment is as follows:

15 Article 14, Section 2. Fees. The legislature shall
16 provide by law the fees which may be demanded by justices
17 of the peace and constables in precincts having less than

1 fifteen hundred population, and of court commissioners,
2 boards of arbitration and notaries public, which fees the
3 said officers shall accept as their full compensation.
4 But all other state, county, city, town and school offi-
5 cers shall be required by law to keep a true and correct
6 account of all fees collected by them, and to pay the same
7 into the proper treasury when collected, and the officer
8 whose duty it is to collect such fees shall be held
9 responsible, under his bond, for neglect to collect the
10 same. ~~7-provided, that in addition to the salary of sheriff~~
11 ~~they--shall be entitled to receive from the party for whom~~
12 ~~the services are rendered in civil cases such fees as--may~~
13 ~~be prescribed by law.~~

14 Section 2. The following statement shall be endorsed
15 on the foregoing proposed amendment by the secretary of
16 state of Wyoming:

17 This amendment deletes the provision entitling sher-
18 iffs to receive in addition to their salaries, fees for
19 rendering services to a party in civil cases.
