

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10 Section 1. W.S. 21-17-115 and 21-18-104 are created

1 to read:

2 21-17-115. Certain nonresidents considered resi-
3 dents.

4 (a) For the purposes of admission and payment of
5 tuition to the University of Wyoming, a person is a resi-
6 dent if:

7 (i) A member of his immediate family has his
8 principal employment in the state, the employment is the
9 principal source of family income and the family member
10 has been continuously employed in this state for one (1)
11 year;

12 (ii) Seventy-five percent (75%) of the federal
13 taxable income of his immediate family for the year pre-
14 ceding his enrollment in the university was earned in this
15 state;

16 (iii) His family's principal residence is
17 within fifty (50) air miles of a boundary of this state;

18 (iv) The state in which he resides has sub-
19 stantially similar statutes or regulations applicable to
20 Wyoming residents.

21 21-18-104. Certain nonresidents considered resi-

1 dents. For the purposes of admission and payment of
2 tuition to a Wyoming community college, a person is a res-
3 ident if the criteria in W.S. 21-17-115 are met.

4 Section 2. W.S. 23-1-102(a)(ix) is amended to read:

5 23-1-102. General definitions.

6 (a) As used in this act:

7 (ix) "Resident" means:

8 (A) A United States citizen who has been
9 a resident of Wyoming for not less than one (1) year and
10 who has not claimed residency elsewhere for any purpose
11 during that one (1) year period immediately preceding the
12 date of application for a license, permit or certificate;

13 ~~and "Resident" also includes~~

14 (B) Any alien who has resided continu-
15 ously in Wyoming for at least one (1) year immediately
16 prior to the date of making application for a game and
17 fish license; OR

18 (C) A PERSON WHO:

19 (1) HAS HIS PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE
20 WITHIN FIFTY (50) AIR MILES OF THIS STATE;

1 (II) HAS HIS PRINCIPAL EMPLOYMENT
2 WITHIN THIS STATE;

(III) HAS BEEN EMPLOYED IN THIS
STATE FOR NOT LESS THAN ONE (1) YEAR PRIOR TO HIS APPLICA-
TION FOR A LICENSE, PERMIT OR CERTIFICATE;

(IV) EARNED NOT LESS THAN SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%) OF HIS FEDERAL TAXABLE INCOME WITHIN THIS STATE FOR THE YEAR PRIOR TO HIS APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, PERMIT OR CERTIFICATE; AND

10 (V) RESIDES IN A STATE WHICH HAS
11 SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR STATUTES APPLICABLE TO WYOMING RESI-
12 DENTS.

13 Section 3. This act is effective June 11, 1986.
