1. According to a spokesman from the State Auditor's Office, they are required to report all reimbursements for meals on one-day round trips on employees' W-2 forms at the end of the year. The following estimate of fiscal impact, based on FY 82 travel reimbursements, was provided:

a. \$380,000 annually for reimbursements to employees for their one-day round trips.

b. \$7,300 for the Auditor's Office to develop the data capture and W-2 reporting system for the one-day round trip meal reimbursements and \$5,400 annually thereafter for processing and reporting.

However, according to the spokesman, current expenditure trends indicate that the expense of implementing the bill could probably be absorbed by the existing biennial appropriation. (Supporting documentation is on file in the Legislative Service Office).

2. The Auditor's Office does not anticipate any personnel impact.
