A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 35-79.27 by creating a new subsection
2 (e) relating to birth certificate cards; authorizing the
3 state registrar to issue such cards to persons born in
4 Wyoming; and providing for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 35-79.27 by creating a new subsection
7 (e) is amended to read:

8 35-79.27. Copies of data from vital records; birth
9 certificate card.

10 (e) THE STATE REGISTRAR OF VITAL RECORDS MAY ISSUE A
11 BIRTH CERTIFICATE CARD TO ANY PERSON BORN IN WYOMING WHICH
12 SHALL RESEMBLE IN APPEARANCE A WYOMING DRIVER'S LICENSE.
13 IT SHALL ADEQUATELY DESCRIBE THE CARDHOLDER, BEAR THE
14 HOLDER'S FINGERPRINT AND BEAR THE FOLLOWING: "STATE OF
15 WYOMING", "BIRTH CERTIFICATE IDENTIFICATION", NAME OF
16 CARDHOLDER, NAME OF PARENTS OF CARDHOLDER, AND PLACE AND

1 DATE OF BIRTH OF THE CARDHOLDER. EACH APPLICANT SHALL PAY
2 A REASONABLE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A BIRTH CERTIFICATE
3 CARD.

4 Section 2. This act is effective May 27, 1977.
