The \$145,000 is based on hunter, angler and boat owners response to the \$1.00 donation to search and rescue for 1997. We feel the same group of people would be at least as responsive to a cause that gave them an even more direct benefit.

There is a potential that the hunters, anglers and boat owners will donate the \$1.00 that they previously donated to Search & Rescue, to the access easement project.

In addition, this bill has administrative impact which appears to increase (or decrease) duties or responsibilities of one or more state agencies and may impact agency spending or staffing requirements. As introduced, the bill does not modify any state agency budget or current personnel authorizations. The following state agencies may be affected administratively:
