

Chapter 115

Enrolled Act No. 89, House of Representatives,
FIFTEENTH LEGISLATURE OF
THE STATE OF WYOMING.

AN ACT appropriating twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) for improvements
to the water works, buildings and grounds of the State Penitentiary.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

SECTION 1. The sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00)
is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the State Treasury not otherwise
appropriated for the completion and improvement of water works and for general
improvements to the buildings and grounds of the State Penitentiary at Rawlins,
Wyoming.

SECTION 2. The moneys hereby appropriated are hereby made avail-
able and shall be expended under the direction of the State Board of Charities
and Reform at such time or times in the years 1919, 1920 and 1921 as may be
deemed expedient.

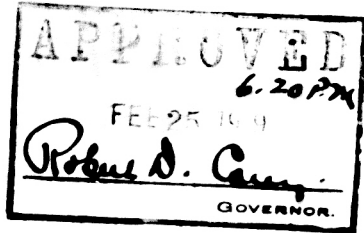
SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and
