- 1 23-2-406. Definitions.
- 2 (a) As used in this act:
- 3 (ii) "Outfitter" means a person including a 4 hunting club, who advertises or holds himself out to the 5 public for hire or remuneration to provide quide or packing services for the purpose of FISHING OR taking any big 6 7 or trophy game animal, excluding any person who furnishes 8 BOATS, pack or riding animals and other equipment only to 9 a FISHERMAN OR hunter for his personal temporary use and 10 any landowner providing outfitter services on private lands owned or leased by him. As used in this paragraph: 11
- "Professional guide" means 12 (iii) any person 13 employed by or operating under an independent contract 14 with a licensed outfitter to furnish personal services for 15 the conduct of outdoor recreational activities for the purpose of FISHING OR hunting animals except any person 16 17 employed by a licensed outfitter solely to care for, groom or saddle livestock, cook, cut wood or to transport peo-18 19 ple, equipment and personal property;
- 20 (iv) "Packing services" means transporting for 21 hire or remuneration, FISHERMEN, hunters, FISH, game ani-22 mals or equipment in the field for the purpose of taking
