8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1. W.S. 23-2-406(a)(ii)(intro), (iii) and
 10 (iv), 23-2-410(c)(v) and 23-2-414(a)(i) and by creating a
 11 new paragraph (iv) are amended to read:

1 23-2-406. Definitions.

2 (a) As used in this act:

3 (ii) "Outfitter" means a person including a
4 hunting club, who advertises or holds himself out to the
5 public for hire or remuneration to provide guide or pack-
6 ing services for the purpose of FISHING OR taking any big
7 or trophy game animal, excluding any person who furnishes
8 BOATS, pack or riding animals and other equipment only to
9 a FISHERMAN OR hunter for his personal temporary use and
10 any landowner providing outfitter services on private
11 lands owned or leased by him. As used in this paragraph:

12 (iii) "Professional guide" means any person
13 employed by or operating under an independent contract
14 with a licensed outfitter to furnish personal services for
15 the conduct of outdoor recreational activities for the
16 purpose of FISHING OR hunting animals except any person
17 employed by a licensed outfitter solely to care for, groom
18 or saddle livestock, cook, cut wood or to transport peo-
19 ple, equipment and personal property;

20 (iv) "Packing services" means transporting for
21 hire or remuneration, FISHERMEN, hunters, FISH, game ani-
22 mals or equipment in the field for the purpose of taking

1 any FISH OR big or trophy game animal;

2 23-2-410. Powers and duties of board; generally;
3 employees; licensing and regulation.

4 (c) The board shall license and regulate outfitters
5 and professional guides in this state and shall:

6 (v) Designate areas within the state as recom-
7 mended by the commission for game AND FISH management pur-
8 poses in which a licensee may conduct outfitting or pro-
9 fessional guiding under the license;

10 23-2-414. License issuance; fees; term of license;
11 renewal; disposition of collected fees.

12 (a) Upon passage of required examination and if it
13 determines the applicant is otherwise in compliance with
14 the requirements of this act and its rules and regula-
15 tions, the board may issue a license upon payment of the
16 applicable fee:

17 (i) HUNTING AND FISHING outfitter's
18 license.....\$300.00;

19 (iv) FISHING OUTFITTER'S LICENSE.....100.00.

20 Section 2. Notwithstanding section 3 of this act, any

1 fishing outfitter or professional fishing guide operating
2 or employed in this state and licensed as an outfitter by
3 the board of outfitters and guides prior to January 1,
4 1994 shall not be required to take any examination or pay
5 any additional fees pursuant to this act.

6 Section 3. This act is effective January 1, 1994.
