7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 9-3-104(a)(iv) and 9-3-105(b) and  
9 (e) are amended to read:

10 9-3-104. Creation of divisions within department.

1 (a) There are created within the department:

2 (iv) The division of community programs.†

5 9-3-105. Division of community programs; powers and

11 (e) "Shelter" means a place of temporary refuge,

15 Section 2. W.S. 9-3-104(a)(v) is repealed.

16 Section 3. This act is effective June 1, 1982.

YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER OR LEGALLY MARRIED;

(ii) "SEXUAL ASSAULT" MEANS ANY ACT MADE CRIMINAL PURSUANT TO W.S. 6-4-302 AND 6-5-102;

(iii) "Shelter" means a place of temporary refuge, offered on a twenty-four (24) hour, seven (7) day per week basis to victims of domestic violence and their children. ~~7-applying-for-grants-from-the-division.~~

(f) THE PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION OF COMMUNITY PROGRAMS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE ADMINISTERED IN COMPLIANCE WITH W.S. 35-1-611 THROUGH 35-1-627.". -HANSEN
