A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to amend Section 2, Chapter 64, Wyoming Session
2 Laws 1947 and to number as W.S. 9-7-103; to amend W.S.
3 9-7-510(b) and (m) and 9-7-610(c)(iv) and by creating a
4 new paragraph (v) relating to distribution of income from
5 lands granted to Wyoming by the Act of Admission for a
6 miner's hospital for miners who become disabled or inca-
7 pacitated while working in the mines of the state; provid-
8 ing that such income shall be credited to an account
9 within the permanent land income fund and shall be divided
10 between the Memorial Hospital of Sweetwater County and the
11 Campbell County Hospital; and providing for an effective

1 date.

2 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

3 Section 1. Section 2, Chapter 64, Wyoming Session
4 Laws 1947 is amended and numbered as W.S. 9-7-103 and W.S.
5 9-7-510(b) and (m) and 9-7-610(c)(iv) and by creating a
6 new paragraph (v) are amended to read:

7 9-7-103. Income from land grant for disabled miners;
8 distribution; conditions and purpose. Section 2,--That
9 while-said-property-is-operated-and-maintained-as-a-hospi-
10 tal-for-miners-who-shall-become-disabled-or--incapacitated
11 for--labor--while--working--in--the-mines-of-the-State,--or
12 shall-make--provision--for--the--hospitalization--of--such
13 miners--in--such--institution, The income, AS PROVIDED BY
14 W.S. 9-7-605(c), from lands granted to the state of
15 Wyoming by the United States of America under the provi-
16 sions of the Act admitting said THE State to the Union,
17 approved July 10, 1890, for a hospital for miners who
18 shall become disabled or incapacitated for labor while
19 working in the mines of the state and-the-income-from-pre-
20 ceeds--derived--from--the--sales-of-said-lands-or-portions
21 thereof, shall, as they accrue, be CREDITED TO AN ACCOUNT
22 WITHIN THE PERMANENT LAND INCOME FUND AND paid to said
23 county MEMORIAL HOSPITAL OF SWEETWATER COUNTY AND TO

1 CAMPBELL COUNTY HOSPITAL IN EQUAL SHARES, to be used for
2 the purposes for which said THE federal grant was made.
